ZOPHIE away alertly, clear on lead, measured through turn, opened up approaching the 1/4 pole, won handily. ONGOING MELODY slow early, hustled to 1/4 pole, angled inside for stretch run, surged for place. CORNISH LOVER laid close up, tracked loose leader, extended lane, hung late. MICROSCOPE off slowly, labored to 1/4 pole, angled out lane, passed weary. ROAN RUBY pushed along off the pace, evenly to lane, lacked late response. MISS WHITFIELD raced second flight, never menaced. MAJIC JESSICA dropped back early, lost ground, no factor. WAR GENIE faded back, always outrun. CRYSTAL PREDICTION showed good early speed, began to labor turn, gave way.
