LADY ON FIRE broke sharply, set all the pace along the inside, drew off to upper stretch winning as much the best while kept to task. ELLE CASHAREAU stalked the pace, chased to upper stretch, proved no match there a clear second best. SOUTHCOTE ROAD off slowly gave a mild rally mid stretch, improved late in the three path. FUHRBEE went evenly off the pace, raced four wide upper stretch, lacked late surge. LIGHT SLEEPER unhurried while saving ground, gave a mild move to upper stretch then weakened. LOVELY AS EVER slow early played no factor. PREACHER failed to respond. ELIZANNIC chased the pace through the backside then gave way on the far turn. SAINT PARASKEYY was always outrun.
