**Footnotes**

MISS DOLAN'S ROSE patiently ridden early, angled towards the inside mid turn, rallied along the rail entering the stretch, angled out mid stretch, split foes late and surged up under clever handling for the victory. MANATEE DIVERS raced up close from the start, bid four wide vying for the lead in mid stretch, was outfinished by the winner late to settle for second place in a good effort. CONNIE'S JUNE MOON tracked to mid turn, bid between foes entering the stretch, loomed off the leader in mid stretch but was outgamed nearing the wire to settle for third best. INVULNERABLE rushed hard shortly after the start taking the lead, set the pace traveling in the two path, headed from both sides upper stretch, battled to deep stretch then weakened missing a minor award. LADY SAXONY settled in the second flight, roused coming five wide in mid stretch, narrowed the gap late finishing in a willing manner. ANGEL IN BLUE tracked along the rail around the turn, came thru a narrow opening top of the lane, vied briefly in a five way battle in mid stretch, leveled off needing more late. BAGATELLE TERRACE was slow early trailing to the quarter pole, swung wide under a drive upper stretch, slightly improved placing but never factored. LADY LANNIS lacked speed running towards the rear, came six wide upper stretch, failed to respond offering little. LET HER ROLE pressed for the early lead running three wide around the bend, began to fade top of the stretch, used up. TWYLIGHT COCKTAILS hustled giving chase around the turn racing four wide, was all done and gave way top of the stretch finishing spent.
