Footnotes

MUE'STRAMEELDINERO set a well rated pace traveling in the two path, challenged by LANGFUHR GLORY in upper stretch, responded to pressure repulsing that threat holding firm to the finish. LANGFUHR GLORY steadily advanced along the rail down the backside, angled out upper stretch taking aim on the winner, loomed from mid stretch but was turned away and settled for second place in a hard effort. WACKY INDIAN lagged far behind for six furlongs, angled out four wide upper stretch, closed willingly picking up the show position. BENBAD settled along the rail towards the rear, angled out top of the lane under a drive, slightly improved placing but never threatened. PURGE THE PAST tracked the pace racing along the rail, began to chase form the quarter pole, lacked rally never menacing. J P EXPRESS stalked the winner to the half racing in the three path, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole and faded from upper stretch. LORDY LORDY LORDY raced evenly in the second flight, dropped off to trail at the quarter pole, finished well beaten.
