Footnotes

DROWN THE SORROWS slow early found stride in upper stretch, with no outside options came hard on the inside to put a head in front of HURRICANE NATALIE a sixteenth out then just held on late. HURRICANE NATALIE tracked a contested pace looming at mid track into upper stretch, ceded a slim lead to DROWN THE SORROWS then bore down with a last surge just missing. SEA OF MUSIC sent hard keeping a head in front of OUTSIDE THE LINES as the pair moved the pace racing off the inside through the turn, collared in upper stretch would cede between horses when a bit weary late. ATHENA'S CROWN laid close up following pressing rivals through the turn, swung wide in upper stretch lacked a closing push. SCALD off slowly trailed through the turn, found belated stride finishing well along the inside. OUTSIDE THE LINES hustled out engaging SEA OF MUSIC on pace pressing rival hard into upper stretch, began to waver in mid drive giving way weary late. PRINCESS HELMA saved ground playing no factor. PHARAWAY WEDDING was always outrun.
