LATE NIGHT HOOKUP broke alertly working to keep a short lead through the turn, digging in near the rail down the stretch would find more gamely. BELIEVE DAT pressured the pace through the turn extending in the three path down the stretch holding well to the end. END OF THE GULCH hustled along the inside pressured hard through the turn to upper stretch, kept after in the two path down the lane continuing to give willing response late. BATON ROUGE bid five deep on the turn pursuing at mid track upper stretch, kept to stiff urging lacked a final surge. CAP'N FELIX chased and pressured the pace on the turn then weakened in the four path upper stretch. TIPSAW pinched at the break stayed back through the turn playing no factor. SPEED BALL was always outrun.
