CATHEDRAL PEAK unhurried leaving the gate, moved off the rail shortly after the start, gained momentum coming five wide entering the stretch, surged strongly in the final sixteenth to snare the victory in last jumps. MORE SWEET SECRETS rushed hard into the far turn, edged clear near the quarter pole, maintained a slim advantage under a drive to the wire but was out nodded by the winner missing in a hard effort. PENCIL PUSHER raced up close saving ground, was in close mid turn and waited briefly turning for home, angled mid stretch, split foes late and surged willingly picking up the show position. SILENT HONOR was forwardly placed traveling in the three path, loomed off the leader mid stretch, needed more late being outfinished for a minor award. MARTINI GOT EVEN stalked early on racing towards the inside, remained a threat to deep stretch, tired late. HAYLEY'S COMMAND lacked speed racing in the second flight, mildly bid from mid stretch racing in the four path. MARILYN'S STAR broke alertly gaining the lead, angled to the rail shortly after the start, dueled with the runner up from mid turn mid stretch then faded to the wire. I STAR trailed soon after the start, guided to the rail saving ground throughout, never factored. MONDAYS GIRL chased briefly at mid track, retreated for mid turn, no factor. K'S TRULYASTARR quickly dropped off, dull effort.
