Footnotes

PROUDTOBOYOURFRIEND dueled outside of WINK AT THE BOYS soon after the start, went head to head around the turn and to deep stretch, slowly edged clear under strong handling to win going away. MYSTERY RIDGE tracked a hot pace racing mid track, angled four wide top of the lane, was under left handed stick and surged late securing second place in last jump. WINK AT THE BOYS broke sharply, dueled running inside of the winner from the start, battled to deep stretch, yielded stubbornly and was out noded missing second place in a game effort. MARIA'S MOON tracked the pace down the backside, roused form the quarter pole, gave chase in the lane, needed more late. MOGEY raced evenly towards the rear, swung six wide upper stretch, needed more while besting rest. EXPLOSIVE STAR well placed stalking early, raced along the inside throughout, weakened from upper stretch. VERY SUPERSTITIOUS was quickly outrun, raced wide down the backside, offered little. NAUSET LIGHT was always outrun, showed little.
