REESE'S ROAR rushed hard soon after the start, cleared DANGER DANGER mid turn, repulsed JOE LOVES MONEY in upper stretch, drew off in mid stretch and was kept to task winning convincingly. WENAHA tracked around the turn, rallied along the rail from upper stretch, finished willingly gaining second place. MR AMES was squeezed and briefly steadied leaving the gate, trailed to mid turn, angled out to the five path top of the lane, hit stride mid stretch, finished fastest of all securing the show position. MONTAGUE BAY well placed tracking the pace, came four wide upper stretch, leveled off and was outfinished for third place. JOE LOVES MONEY pressed the winner to mid turn traveling three wide, could not keep pace from upper stretch, weakened inside the furlong marker. JUST FUHR REAL broke a bit out brushing MR AMES, raced along the rail mid turn, angled out to split foes mid stretch, lacked needed kick. THE GREEN KNIGHT raced evenly in the second flight, failed to respond, varied little. DANGER DANGER flashed brief foot, stalked then chased the winner top top of the stretch, gave way finishing spent. EVIL TOWN was urged leaving the gate but failed to respond, never factored.
