Footnotes

TRACK RECORD slow early rushed up five deep on turn, dueled from the four path down the stretch edging clear driving. PALAPPEAL away alertly pressed on a short lead to upper stretch, dueling in the three path was outfinished. ROUNDUP JADE rushed up four deep on the turn, extended in three path down the lane would hang late. MISTER ANDERSON chased the pace early, steadied entering the stretch, gave an even finish along the inside. KYLE'S TREASURY went evenly in mid pack, angled five wide upper stretch, held position with even action. FRANCONA slow early played no factor. ALL THERE was never involved. DEAVER bumped at the start stayed back. FAR EAST GOLD pressed the pace through the turn then gave way in upper stretch. CASSIUS CASEY chased early then faded on the turn, took a bad step upper stretch and was eased.
