Footnotes

COASTING IN hustled early and stalked along the inside to upper stretch, angled out and brushed with HENNEPIN COUNTRY a couple of times making room inside the furlong marker, surged clear late receiving strong left handed stick. HENNEPIN COUNTRY stalked around the turn, bid in tandem with the winner from upper stretch, was brushed inside the eighth pole by COASTING IN while vying for the lead, was outfinished by that rival coming to the wire proving a game second best. TIGERS LAST broke alertly but was soon headed by LIONSON, matched strides to top of the lane, battled to deep stretch, ceded stubbornly holding on to third place. LIONSON rushed shortly after the start, put a head in front mid turn, vied to deep stretch, weakened late. MAGICAL BRAVADO lacked speed, angled to the rail upper stretch under a drive, mildly gained coming to the finish line but never threatened. FLASH FOREVER varied little racing at mid track, failed to menace. NATIVE CRY was quickly outrun, raced wide throughout never factoring.
