Footnotes

SAPPHIRE HILL well placed into the backstretch, stalked a quick pace racing 3 wide into the far turn, roused to draw even abreast rivals in upper stretch, edged away under a drive. MOSTLY DEVIOUS broke alertly following GLITTERING CHAD to the backside, prompted a quick pace through the far turn, collared from the outside by SAPPHIRE HILL dueling between horses into upper stretch, went extended late to save place. PRINCESS TERLINGUA raced evenly to the backside, moved up 4 wide to loom a threat into the far turn, dropped off a bit there recovering to menace in upper stretch, moved evenly on the outside of rivals lacking a closing surge. JOYOUS APPEAL taken back early, saved ground edging closer near the 1/2, roused through the far turn angling out in upper stretch, gave even action posing no late threat. BLAZING COUNTESS away slowly, trailed the field saving ground throughout, had limited response lane needing more. GLITTERING CHAD hustled to make the early lead, collected measuring a slim lead through the backside, answered outside pressure on the far turn, couldn't shake clear wearing down near the rail.
