PRINCE ROONEY pressed for the lead racing three to four wide going down the backside, asked near the quarter pole, quickly responded to draw off easily, won as much the best. KID KEARNY GABE settled in the second flight traveling off the rail, asked at the quarter pole, swung five wide top of the lane, got up in deep stretch gaining the place position. TUFFY COTTRELL showed good speed, vied for the lead racing between foes to the quarter pole, was no match for PRINCE ROONEY top of the lane, was outgamed at the finish vying for second place, hard effort. ANGUS KAHN broke a bit outward, was quickly angled to the rail going down the backside, loomed off of duelers going into the far turn, chased under a drive past the quarter pole, weakened in the drive. MARLIN PASS lacked speed, raced mid track throughout, failed to factor despite being hard ridden. PURGATORY DANCER was a step slow from the gate, was outrun never involved. ZIP IN TIME showed good early foot, vied briefly in a three way duel to the far turn, dropped off coming to the quarter pole, was struggling in upper stretch and eased near the eighth pole.
