Footnotes

ALLENSWORTH stalked along the inside going down the backside, bid mid turn engaging SILVER MAN CAN for the lead, drove clear turning for home, raced in the two path to the wire, held sway late under steady encouragement. I'M WAITING FOR U unhurried leaving the gate, raced far off the pace, gained momentum leaving the quarter pole, came four wide top of the stretch, closed in on the winner nearing the wire, was easily second best. SILVER MAN CAN set the pace traveling three wide, headed by the winner midway on the turn, battled to the quarter pole, chased from upper stretch, weakened mid stretch holding on to third place. TAINTED WITNESS raced evenly in mid pack, roused mid turn, angled towards the inside for the stretch run, failed to menace. TREKKIE stalked to the half running four wide, began to give way near the quarter pole, was no factor in the lane, finished weary. BOBS TIEBREAKER was forwardly placed, stalked running three wide throughout, had little left by upper stretch, gave way at the eighth pole. BOLD COMMAND was unprepared as the gate sprang open, raced far behind early on, put to the whip midway on the backside, failed to respond and never factored in a dull effort.
