Footnotes

THE ALCOVA KID broke slowly staying back while racing off the inside through the far turn, fired six wide in upper stretch then angled in to the four path while sweeping clear late. LUIGI'S HONOUR set the pace through the far turn digging in from the two path upper stretch, overpowered from the outside held well to salvage place. OPTIMER (ARG) unhurried early advanced to contention on the far turn, came five wide in upper stretch bidding evenly from mid track late. DONERAILE'S PEAK well rated rallied on the far turn threatening in the three path upper stretch, extending late came up a bit short. SPIDER POWER (IRE) settled inside early gained on the far turn pressing from the rail in upper stretch, failed to sustain the effort weakening gradually the final eighth. SMOKY KNIGHT played no factor. MR. REGENT prompted the pace into the far turn weakening there giving way in the three path upper stretch. ASTUTEST had some early speed then retreated abruptly on the far turn.
