**Footnotes**

NAVAJO SPIRIT hustled into the first turn, cleared and angled over to the rail, set a solid pace throughout, was put to a drive mid stretch as lead was diminishing, held safe under strong handling. JAZZ COURT stalked the winner while saving ground, angled out a bit upper stretch taking aim, inched closer nearing the wire, missed in a hard effort. STEEL THE REWARD bumped with DIABLO GUAPO shortly after the start, dropped off to trail, sat patient to the far turn, gained on the bend, came six wide top of the stretch, surged strongly coming to the wire picking up the show position in willing manner. MY BOY ANGIE stalked early on, mounted bid racing three wide at the quarter pole, failed to sustain move and was outfinished for a minor award. BALLADOS PROSPECT was hard held in the early going, settled in the second flight, raced off the rail going into the far turn, lost ground coming seven wide entering the stretch, gave belated action but was no real threat. CAPTAIN STONE saved ground to mid turn, angled out and raced four wide chasing entering the stretch, flattened out mid stretch. FAST FLING showed good early speed, stalked the winner to the half, chased on the bend, gave way upper stretch. BACKSTAGE DRAMA settled in the second flight, traveled four to five wide for most of the trip, lacked response never factoring. ONE DAY well placed tracking to the far turn, urged on the bend, gave no response and gave way leaving the quarter pole. DIABLO GUAPO bumped with STEEL THE REWARD shortly leaving the gate, trailed form the half, never involved.
