Footnotes

READY SET settled in off the pace giving a prompted move into the far turn, advanced quickly angling inside while grabbing a short lead in upper stretch, challenged late from the outside by WEB GEM would hold on determinedly. WEB GEM unhurried in the early going came in close quarters to the far turn, found stride inside the three sixteenths pole moving to leaders, looking for room was angled between horses an eighth out surging abreast READY SET late missing gamely. REAL APPEAL away slowly began to respond on the outside to upper stretch, surged steadily at mid track in drive. CHEROKEE ARTIST stalked the pace racing well of the inside to the far turn, rallied there grabbing a short lead near the quarter pole, collared by READY SET into upper stretch ceded to rival coming up short late. MY PAL CHARLIE stalked the pace racing off the inside moving to leaders on the backside, chased CHEROKEE ARTIST through the far turn then gradually wore down the final sixteenth. PROUD KENTUCKIAN tucked inside early gave a mild move out of the far turn then leveled off in drive. I'VE HEARD IT ALL was never a factor. Z FORTUNE rated early moved to a striking position on the backside, hard ridden through the far turn would wilt under pressure. RECAPTURETHEGLORY sent up for the early lead was worked on quick splits through the backside, folded up from use on the far turn. STOLEN CHEVY hustled out would prompt the pace three deep to the half, had nothing left entering the far turn. ACTING ZIPPY pressed the pace for half a mile then gave way into the far turn. An objection from the rider of WEB GEM against the rider of READY SET citing interference as the horses entered the far turn was disallowed by the stewards.
