**Footnotes**

BOBBIE'S DEVIL hustled from the gate, tracked around the bend, came four wide into the lane, wore down foes inside the eighth pole edging away late under strong handling. TWOFIVEFIVESLEW raced up close from the start, bid three wide upper stretch, vied for command deep stretch, was outfinished late holding on to second place in a game effort. NEVEREVERYIELD settled in the second flight, gained along the inside from upper stretch, angled out five wide for room in deep stretch, gave belated surge picking up the show position. MR. BOURBON STREET settled in mid pack, urged while coming five wide upper stretch, gained ground nearing the wire finishing with interest. THE ONE TO CHASE well placed early, racing towards the inside throughout, was outgamed late vying for a minor award. DUTY ROSTER trailed to the quarter pole, raced five wide from upper stretch, showed late interest improving position after the fact. GATO ESPACIAL quickly showed in front, set the pace racing along the rail, battled to mid stretch, gave way at the sixteenth pole. AMERICAN MINER settled in the second flight, made a brief bid mid turn, came six wide into the lane, weakened from mid stretch. ROYALNREGAL DREAMS lacked speed racing off the rail down the backside, asked for more but failed to respond, offered little. JAY'S SUAVE was hustled from the gate, gave chase to mid turn, gave way past the quarter pole and stopped mid stretch finishing weary.
