BORA BORA BOY broke alertly setting the pace through the turn moving off in upper stretch, in charge the final eighth won ridden out. DREAM OF SIDNEY hard ridden early advanced along the rail leaving the turn, no match for the winner down the lane held well a clear second best. GO FASTER FOREST chased the pace through the turn dropping off the leaders in upper stretch, gave even action under a stiff drive outbidding the others from mid track. JAKES STORM BUCK slow early circled out to upper stretch bidding evenly six wide. BOGEY FOR BLADE hustled off the pace failed to menace racing in the four path. MR. BRAGGADOCIO sent hard pursued close up through the turn then faded in the three path upper stretch. SNEAKY DREAMS hustled inside chased along the rail through the turn giving way in upper stretch. MIRROR BALL was always outrun. BUZZIN READY offered little.
