Footnotes

NORTHERN LUCK patiently ridden down the backside saving ground, put to a drive at the quarter pole, and quickly cleared taking the lead entering the stretch when MACHIAVELIQUE bore out, repulsed a threatening SERIOUS OUTLAW with a furlong to go and increased margin being kept to task. SERIOUS OUTLAW raced up close traveling three wide, set down top of the stretch, loomed off the winner at the eighth pole, was turned away and finished a willing second. MACHIAVELIQUE set a rated pace traveling a little off the rail, challenged by MISTER PADDY coming to the quarter pole, began to bear out carrying out that rival entering the stretch, righted self in upper stretch and gave chase to the wire, just managing to hold third place under strong encouragement. MISTER PADDY was bumped and took up briefly when TAYLORS POINT veered in at the break, moved out to the four path entering the backside, made a steady advance going into the far turn, almost drew even with MACHIAVELIQUE near the quarter pole, was carried out and steadied turning for home when that rival bore out, gave chase in the stretch run but was no late threat just missing the show position. A CLAIM OF FOUL FROM THE RIDER OF MISTER PADDY AGAINST THE RIDER OF MACHIAVELIQUE FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE STRETCH WAS DENIED BY THE STEWARDS. LARRY AND ELAINE settled in the second flight, gained mid turn, raced four wide under a drive into the lane, leveled off needing more. TAYLORS POINT broke in bumping MISTER PADDY, rushed up stalking from the three path to the half, failed to respond when asked for more and weakened in the drive. BELL FLOP lacked speed running in the second flight throughout, offered little. ROB'S SILVER WEDGE raced evenly along the rail, failed to factor. INDY SIGNAL was always outrun in a dull performance.
