Footnotes

LUCKY DRUMMER rushed four wide into the first turn, cleared going down the backside, felt pressure throughout, fought hard under strong handling to the finish, just lasted being fully extended. HAJJI'S HONOR was patiently ridden to the far turn, launched rally near the quarter pole, came four wide top of the stretch, surged in deep stretch to narrowly miss, game effort. PLEASANT COMPANY went unhurried from the gate, raced off the rail down the backside, gained momentum at the quarter pole, split rivals mid stretch, surged between at the wire to snare the show position. TIZ A COUP broke for the lead and was in close quarters going into the first turn, clipped heels off of LUCKY DRUMMER and checked briefly, settled in good stalking position, put to a drive entering the stretch, loomed with a furlong to go but needed a bit more late. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS SOON FOLLOWED BY A CLAIM OF FOUL FROM THE RIDER OF TIZ A COUP AGAINST THE RIDER OF LUCKY DRUMMER FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE FIRST TURN, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED. TWOFIVEFIVESLEW rushed five wide into the first turn, pressed the winner throughout, remained a threat to mid stretch, flattened out late. BREWSTER settled in mid pack, raced off the rail around the bend, asked for more, lacked response. RAYWICK was forwardly placed racing along the inside, chased under urging from mid turn, failed to respond, never menaced. BROOKLIME (IRE) flashed brief foot racing near the leaders going into the first turn, settled in mid pack, retreated leaving the far turn, never factored. SICILIAN BOY rated and raced along the rail while trailing, swung wide under a drive entering the stretch, failed to factor in a dull effort.
