Footnotes

A BRIDLED TIGER sent hard early and dueled with CHAMP DE MARS to the three eighths pole, put that rival away at the quarter pole, widened advantage in upper stretch, held safe margin under steady handling. BAIRDS VILLAGE settled early and traveling five wide down the backside, rallied mid turn and angled towards the inside at the quarter pole, chased loose winner from upper stretch, never menaced but had to dig in coming to the wire saving second place. BOLD ABBOTT was off slowly and trailed to mid turn, found stride turning for home, bid along the rail mid stretch, vied coming to the wire for second place but was outgamed and settled for third place in a willing effort. STORM THIS was moved off the rail going down the backside, swung five wide into the stretch giving chase, leveled off mid stretch, besting rest. CHIMCHAR unhurried early, angled to the rail mid turn, hard ridden from the quarter pole, lacked response. HOLY HIGH VIKING well placed early running four wide stalking the pace, chased under urging mid turn, gave way leaving the quarter pole, used up. CHAMP DE MARS was hard used matching strides with the winner down the backstretch, could not keep pace entering the stretch, gave way upper and stopped a sixteenth out finishing spent.
