Footnotes

SUNSHINE LION quickly showed in front, set all the pace racing a little off the rail, was kept to task from the eighth pole holding safe to the wire. CHALLENGER broke well stalking the winner, gave chase racing two to three wide from top of the lane, was slowly cutting into the margin nearing the wire finishing a willing second. FULL HORSE POWER hustled leaving the gate, tracked around the bend, bid in upper stretch, leveled off besting rest. SHOW ME THE CASH was moved off the rail shortly after the start, came under a drive running four to five wide, lacked needed respond. NEPOBEDIMIY lacked speed, saved ground around the bend, never menaced. SOVEREIGN ROAD lacked speed, offered little, briefly steadied in upper stretch avoiding fallen rival. ONE VOTE was always outrun, briefly steadied in upper stretch avoiding fallen foe. SNOW MON showed good early speed, stalked the winner to mid turn, began to tire past the quarter pole, drifted out entering the stretch, broke down and fell in upper stretch.
