Footnotes

WHARPED taken back and tucked inside early, roused nearing the 1/2 mile pole, angled out and drew to weary pacesetters on second turn, blew clear into stretch, won much the best . VICKY'S STAGE went evenly behind a wall of dueling rivals to the 1/2 mile pole, surged near the rail to the 1/4 pole, split horses at the head of the stretch, responded willingly under a drive to finish clearly second best . WOODMAVEN hustled close up, pressed the issue racing 5 wide down the backside, went in tandem entering stretch 4 wide, wore down inside the 1/8 pole but was good enough to hold off others . TRAPP RICO showed early foot along the rail, contested for a 1/2 mile, dropped off on last turn, angled out to mid track stretch and finished weary . BRIDAL GAL sent hard from the gate, rushed along 6 wide to the 1/2, continued all out while wide on final turn, had nothing left into stretch . SWEET CANE made a short early lead, was used under pressure on the pace, hung in to the 1/4 pole, had enough into stretch and gave way . BAT LADY bumped hard leaving the gate, had brief speed then quickly retreated . SWEET AND CLASSI sent hard inside, pressed under a ride for a 1/2 mile, wilted from the 3/8 pole, was eased to finish . ALLEN'S HEIRESS displayed laboring form and was eased after a 1/2 mile .
