Footnotes

REZIF unhurried early saved ground through the far turn swinging out seven wide in upper stretch finding a late burst to surge up in the closing yards. WIND ON THE HILL stalked the pace racing four wide through the backside edging closer to loom boldly at mid track in upper stretch, would drift a bit in drive proving game while ceding to a wide closing REZIF. FAULKWOOD SHORES sent clear set the pace racing away from the rail to the far turn, collared from the outside in upper stretch would battle back giving all while ceding late. BLUE CHERRIES SPIN tracked close up to the far turn saving ground cutting the corner to upper stretch, extended along the rail showed willing though needing more. FLIP FLOP forwardly placed pressed to even terms in upper stretch, dueling late was outfinished. KENNY'S LAD slow early trailed the field through the far turn, had modest improvement while racing between horse along the inside down the stretch. AKEBONO tracked the pace remaining in range to upper stretch, hard roused there would waver late. P. P'S TO FOLLOW played no factor. TEXAS HOLLADAY was never involved.
