Footnotes

TAPIZAR moved clear going into the first turn, traveled off the rail setting a pressured pace, headed and lost the lead briefly to SERUNI at the quarter pole, rider asked for more entering the stretch and quickly responded to drew off, won convincingly under steady handling. HEADACHE was taken in hand leaving the gate and angled to the rail, lagged far off the pace running along the inside, roused near the quarter pole, gained momentum top of the lane, finished strongly getting up late for second place. SERUNI pressed the winner going down the backstretch, drew even mid turn and put a head in front at the quarter pole, proved no match from mid stretch, lost ground and was outfinished late fighting for second place. COLIZEO raced up close to the far turn saving ground, angled off the rail under a drive mid turn, gave chase entering the stretch, lacked needed punch and never threatened in the drive. PARODY raced evenly towards the rear traveling four to five wide down the backside, failed to respond when asked, no factor. POPULIST POLITICS tracked to mid turn racing off the rail, began to fade entering the stretch, stopped mid stretch and finished being eased across the wire.
