Footnotes

MACHO MACHO stalked the pace racing off the inside traveling in or about the four path to the far turn, edged closer at the quarter pole bidding between horses in the three path upper stretch, wrestled a short lead a sixteenth out then held off a rail running BOURBON COURAGE to prevail. BOURBON COURAGE well rated through the backside began to respond on the far turn, cut the corner into upper stretch surging under a stiff drive on the rail pressing MACHO MACHO to the end. CALLED TO SERVE sat patient through the backside moving to bid on the far turn, vied four deep in upper stretch extending willingly abreast rivals while being outfinished. HANSEN breaking well tried in vain to clear HERO OF ORDER, raced abreast that one in the four path as the pair carried a soft pace into the far turn, briefly saw daylight near the quarter pole then was re engaged dueling between horses into upper stretch, extending late in the two path would wear down. HERO OF ORDER away alertly joined HANSEN on pace matching strides inside of rival through the far turn, wavered into upper stretch fading outside the eighth pole. PENN'S GRANT varying little throughout was never involved. MACHO BULL was always outrun. Z CAMELOT showed little racing six and seven wide through the stretch. LE BERNARDIN a step slow while in a bit close at the break would fold up on the far turn easing to the wire.
