Footnotes

MAJOR MARVEL well placed off a fast pace edged to the leaders on the far turn wresting a short lead along the inside in upper stretch, angling toward the rail edged clear under a drive. TONTO FONTENOT unhurried early on responded when prompted on the far turn, bid four path upper stretch rallying late to salvage place. SNEAKIN THRU well rated in the early going angled out in upper stretch, vying at mid track improved position late. TAINO ducked out leaving the gate, stalked close up pressing on the far turn, dueling in the three path upper stretch came up short late. EL COMMODORE tracked evenly moving to threaten on the far turn, extending in the four path down the stretch would hang late. SHOW THE WAY J went evenly through the backside, saved ground moving up on the far turn, weakened at the rail in upper stretch. MIDDIE slow early lost ground down the backside playing no factor. STRIKE IMPACT raced mid pack moving five wide on the backside, wavered on the far turn tiring to upper stretch. LOUGHMOREMAN was never involved.

PLUTONIUM sent clear set a brisk pace to the far turn, collared by TAINO there would give way into upper stretch. FOR YOU REPPPO showed little.
