Footnotes

WILD GOOSE CREEK raced in good tracking position, mounted rally coming five wide top of the lane, drew abreast at the eighth pole, slowly drew clear in deep stretch being kept to task. SIXTH FORMAL stalked a loose leader around the turn, closed in entering the stretch, bid four wide upper stretch, vied for the lead racing between foes mid stretch, was outfinished by the winner but dug late in holding onto second place. RACKEM STACKEM bumped hard at the break with CABERS LION, hustled up racing mid pack, gained along the rail from mid stretch, finished willingly. RAYWICK settled in the second flight racing mid track, asked from the quarter pole, mildly bid improving placing but failed to menace. ITSAFFIRMED quickly showed in front, opened clear lead mid turn, faltered inside the eighth pole, used up. MARKET TUMBLE trailed early, passed a couple of weary rivals improving placing but never factored. CABERS LION bumped hard with RACKEM STACKEM leaving the gate, raced towards the rear throughout, offered little. LOUIE FLAMINGO gave a brief chase, retreated near the quarter pole, stopped upper stretch and was eased across the finish line.
