**Footnotes**

SEAHAG quickly showed in front, angled towards the rail setting all of the pace, was never seriously threatened and increased advantage from upper stretch, won easily being ridden out. IMA GIVEN settled along the rail tracking the pace around the bend, angled out and split rivals mid stretch racing in close quarters, surged willingly gaining second place. EMPRESS BAY rated and raced in the second flight, cut the corner entering the stretch, rallied along the rail from mid stretch, just missed second place. BEA'S HARD SIX broke alertly bit was soon out sprinted for the lead by the winner, stalked along the rail, angled out a bit in mid stretch giving chase, came to the wire racing between foes fighting for a minor award, tired late missing third place. PERFECT ANGEL settled in the second flight, gained mid turn and raced four wide at the quarter pole, moved out a bit wider in mid stretch under a drive, needed more never menacing. MIDNIGHT ABBEY lacked speed and raced along the rail, showed belated interest improving placing but never threatened. ITALIAN REVOLUTION raced evenly at mid track, swung six wide upper stretch, failed to factor. ACT OF BEAUTY flashed brief speed running between foes on the turn, had no response and tired from mid stretch. MISS DOLAN'S ROSE stalked to the quarter pole racing in the two path, gave way from mid stretch. NAUSET LIGHT was always outrun, offered little.
