Footnotes

BLACK WING trailed down the backside racing off the rail, rallied mid turn, came four wide taking aim on a weakening leader upper stretch, bid in tandem with LITE MUSIC from the eighth pole, outfinished that rival and won going away. LITE MUSIC tracked racing towards the inside, angled a bit entering the stretch, bid three wide running inside of BLACK WING in upper stretch, vied in a three way battle in deep stretch, was outfinished by the winner and then just got the nod securing second place. ITZMIN rushed soon after the start, opened up of the field setting a rapid pace, began to shorten stride a sixteenth out, was overpowered by the winner and missed second place on the wire. HACHI lacked speed traveling mid track, swung five to six wide top of the lane, improved placing but was no real threat. CHIPCO showed good early speed stalking then chasing a rapid pace, began to weaken turning for home, no factor in the lane. OPPORTUNITY TO RUN stalked early, gave chase on the bend running between foes, had no late kick and weakened in the lane. BALANCE BEAM broke in and was steadied briefly leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, angled out four to five wide under a drive top of the stretch, lacked response, no factor. ON THE WING well placed in the early stages, raced along the inside from the quarter pole, gave way mid stretch.
