Footnotes

HAP'S GOOD TIMES broke alert to battle for the lead, went clear racing mid track on the turn, widened margin without encouragement, won in hand late. HELLO MINERVA was away slowly, raced wide mid turn, put to a drive near the 1/4 pole, swung 6 wide top of the stretch, closed willingly and got up for the place position. CRAFTY RUTH hustled from the gate, tracked racing between rivals throughout, was under a stiff drive but failed to rally. KEY TO ANGELINE raced evenly in mid pack, angled to the rail on the turn, asked in upper stretch, managed a mild response but was no factor. CART'S MIRACLE broke evenly, rushed a bid while five wide mid turn, chased the winner entering the stretch, failed to sustain rally and weakened in mid stretch. NO MORE TAX sent hard, pressed early, traveled between foes in the lane, tired from the eighth pole. COAXIAL lacked speed, raced in the second flight, roused near the 1/4 pole, drifted wide in upper stretch while under a drive, no factor. HAWAII PROSPECTOR showed brief speed, tracked early racing between foes, chased under a drive from the 1/4 pole, weakened mid stretch. FLIRT had no speed and offered little. LOW VISIBILITY hustled but lacked early foot, dropped off mid turn, never involved.
