HONOR EVENING settled nicely racing towards the rear, rallied mid turn splitting rivals, angled to the rail entering the stretch, vied briefly in four way battle, drew off and won in hand coming to the wire. BUCK THE TREND raced up close stalking duelers down the backstretch, angled out leaving the quarter pole, came five to six wide top of the lane almost drawing even for the lead, was no match for the winner with a furlong to go but gamely proved second best. WHITE FLAME unhurried early and trailed to the half, found stride entering the stretch, gave belated action improving placing but never menaced. BANDJOLAIS raced up close to the half, bid mid turn traveling three wide, vied at the quarter pole, fought to upper stretch under a stiff drive, had little left from mid stretch weakening. GO GO MOJO hustled early and pressed for the lead, took a slight edge going into the far turn, battled to top of the lane running between foes, tired mid stretch. GO FLIGHT was hard used in the early stages, set a pressured pace to the half, began to drop off leaving the quarter pole, finished spent. WATRALSOUTHERNCURE was hard ridden leaving the gate, lacked response, urged again going into the far turn, failed to fire never threatening. JET FLAG raced five wide into the first turn, remained wide throughout, faded mid turn showing little.
