FAST PROMISES broke alert to the early lead, pressed hard on the turn re established a clear margin in upper stretch digging in from the four path finding more late. WONDER WAY away slowly swung out on the turn, bid seven wide down the stretch going all out abreast rivals getting a nose down for place at the wire. BELIEVE DAT chased the pace pressing up to challenge on the turn, extending at mid track down the lane stayed on to the end. BLANK CHECK hopped missing the break, rushed in bid vied three deep on the turn, came six wide upper stretch giving willing response the final eighth. MIDNIGHT THUNDER raced evenly through the turn, roused in the four path upper stretch lacked a late response. SHAMELESS RISK racing a step slow in mid pack moved in the three path down the lane failing to menace. WILD ALEX was always outrun. DOOMER showed little.
