PUT ME IN broke alertly to pursue THAT'S OUR TRICKY into the turn, duelled from between horses coming 4 wide into the lane, asserted control inside the 1/8 pole, widened margin under steady handling. BANISHED LOVER hustled up along the inside, drew to even terms battling between horses to the 1/4 pole, extended under a drive through the lane, proved no late match for PUT ME IN, showed heart rallying for place. OUR JOSEPHINA rushed to contest the early pace, caught wide dueling into the turn, went head and head to the top of the lane, gradually wore down from use. THAT'S OUR TRICKY broke sharply to hustle an early lead into the turn, was quickly joined by a trio of rivals going all out to the 1/4 pole, asked for more reaching the lane, became leg weary giving way late. LOVE YOU MADLY couldn't go with a contested early pace, roused while fading further back on the turn, played no factor in drive. SARAH JADE outrun early, was never involved. COBRA LADY struggled for stride off a quick pace, circled out 6 wide in upper stretch, had no late surge. WORLDLY PLEASURE sent hard racing off the pace, made no headway through the turn, had little left in drive. NATTITUDE flashed early speed, retreated soon after entering the turn.
