Footnotes

EAVESDROPPER raced evenly off a quick opening 1/4, angled out 4 wide approaching the 1/4 pole, fired quickly to draw even abreast rivals in mid stretch, locked up on the outside of FRANKIE R'S WINNER from the 1/16 pole, went in tandem prevailing in final strides. FRANKIE R'S WINNER away well to lay off an early duel, following hard used pacesetters through the turn, pounced from between horses in upper stretch, went head and head on the inside of EAVESDROPPER from the 1/16 pole, proved tenacious dropping a close decision. CROSSING POINT sent for the early lead, engaged from the outside by CALENDAS as the pair dueled briskly to the 1/4 pole, pinned on the inside when joined by FRANKIE R'S WINNER and EAVESDROPPER who had emerged near mid track, tried to dig deep but earlier use had taken a toll. STERLING GOLD exchanged bumps with KASPAROV as the pair jostled each other in the early going, was taken to the rail at the 5/8 pole, moved to contention in upper stretch, responded evenly when needing more late. SECRET ROMEO away slowly, trailed the field through the turn, circled out 6 wide in upper stretch, gave an even late bid. FOUNDING CHAIRMAN outrun early, varied little racing to the 1/4 pole, set down at mid track, had no late surge. KASPAROV exchanged bumps with STERLING GOLD in the early going, raced wide from the 5/8 pole laboring home. CALENDAS sent hard to contest the early pace, pressed abreast CROSSING POINT on brisk fractions through the turn, had enough once reaching the lane, folded up there.
