**Footnotes**

WIGGINS well rated to stalk early racing 3 wide, asked mid turn, took lead entering the stretch, was kept to task and drew off late. ASK THE LORD nicely rated while saving ground down the backside, asked far turn, bid between foes on the turn, angled 5 wide top of the lane, closed strongly in the drive for the place position. CHEROKEE'S BOY hustled from gate, raced 5 wide into the first turn, tracked while up close backstretch, asked mid turn, bid and vied near the 1/4 pole, chased WIGGINS from upper stretch, leveled off late. ROAR OF THE TIGER was taken back leaving the gate, reserved to far turn, asked near 3/8 pole, rallied 6 wide top of the stretch, improved late but was no threat. BADA BAM BADA BOOM sent hard, pressed and dueled while racing between rivals down the backstretch, vied to the 1/4 pole, weakened in mid lane racing along the inside from early efforts. PEGASO (PER) came away in good stalking position racing along the rail, was roused near the 3/8 pole, continued under a drive but offered little in the stretch run. TOUR THE HIVE hustled leaving the gate, raced 4 wide into the first turn, dropped off entering the backstretch, roused on turn, gave no response. ONE COLONY unhurried leaving the gate, was outrun from there, never involved. PRINCE BENJAMIN sent hard, set a pressured pace along the rail for the opening half, stopped near the 3/8 pole, was eased in upper stretch.
