PIQUANTE CAT broke sharply engaging the pace from between horses through the turn, wrested a clear lead in upper stretch then drew off under a drive. ANTARCTIC slow early varied little on the turn, found stride inside the eighth pole surging past tired rivals late to salvage place. ALRIGHT NOW hard ridden with little response through the turn was swung seven wide in upper stretch finding belated action to gain position late. CONNOISSEUR sent hard worked on a slim lead through the turn, extended along the inside through the lane would wear to pressure. WILD PURSUIT slow early was angled to mid track in upper stretch remaining no menace there. SNOWMAN hustled out pressured the pace racing three deep through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. LASTRAW chased early then gave steady retreat. CAPTAIN PETE away slowly would labor throughout.
