Footnotes

DEMARCATIION was allowed to lag far off the pace for the opening half mile, roused at the three eighths pole, rapidly picked up the pace leaving the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch, blew by CRYPTOLIGHT with fifty yards to go to win going away. CRYPTOLIGHT settled nicely racing three to four wide to the half, set down mid turn, bid four wide heading ALMA D'ORO in upper stretch, drove clear at the eighth pole, was overpowered by the winner late but was easily second best. Z HUMOR set a pressured pace to the half, lost control leaving the quarter pole running along the rail, was no match for top pair, angled out late coming again to snare the show position in willing try. ALMA D'ORO stalked to the quarter pole, bid for the lead and vied entering the stretch, could not keep pace inside the eighth pole and faded late. COSMIC lacked speed and trailed running four wide, failed to respond when asked, no factor. BOOMING COMPS was always outrun, never involved. SHADOWBDANCING pressed to the half, dropped off mid turn, stopped in upper stretch and was eased across the finish line.
