MONARCH'S FLAME well rated emerged to threaten in the three path upper stretch, suddenly ducked out seven wide mid drive rallying clear on the outside. KAZOOM hopped at the break, stalked through the backside wrestling the lead on the far turn, dug in from the three path then angled out toward mid track late ceding to wide pressure. GENEOLGY GIRL tracked the pace varying little through the far turn, set down in the four path upper stretch gave an even finish. LA PESCADITA set the pace while traveling in hand, passed on the far turn would wilt in the three path upper stretch. FECKTABLOUS played no factor finishing up six wide. DOUBLE SHADOW was always outrun. SUNDAY BREAKUP stalked along the inside before giving way on the far turn. I'LL FIND YOU dropping back early was always outrun.
