Footnotes

A SLICK CHIC unhurried leaving the gate, angled to mid track at the three eighths pole, swung six to seven wide upper stretch, surged strongly from mid stretch to arrive in time for the victory. PERFECT ANGEL settled in the early going, rushed on the bend traveling four wide, dueled with LEXY MAY BLESSING entering the stretch, gained a slight lead in deep stretch, could not hold off A SLICK CHIC in last jumps, settled for second best in a game effort. LEXY MAY BLESSING was a step slow from the gate, rushed between rivals to take the lead, set a pressured pace racing along the rail, battled hard from top of the stretch, was outfinished by top pair late, holding off others. KATIE MURPHY tracked running four wide around the bend, raced six wide under a drive mid stretch, improved position but needed a bit more late. RISING BAROMETER hustled from the gate, pressed thru the turn, began to chase top of the lane, lacked rally and tired late being outfinished for a minor award. STUNNING ELECTRA moved to the rail shortly after the start, loomed off duelers at the quarter pole, put to a stiff drive upper stretch, lacked rally and weakened late. RUNZEN lacked speed racing mid track, showed little. ANNE'S DANCER raced along the rail throughout, steadily faded from mid turn, no factor. MISS MENIFEE lacked speed, raced along the inside, asked at the quarter pole, lacked response offering little.
