Footnotes

GROOMSMAN away slowly found stride when emerging at mid track in upper stretch, as BOOTS began to falter would sweep by late to win going away. WHAT'S UP DUDE slow early would rally into upper stretch, angled out slightly surging late to move past BOOTS salvaging place. BOOTS broke alert moving sharply to clear MORNING GLOW on the turn, digging in for the drive would drift inside despite repeated attempts by the rider to angle out under a left handed whip, faltered badly in the closing yards. GENERAL DEPUTY sat close up stalking BOOTS through the turn to upper stretch, put to a drive had no late surge. DASHING DEPUTY was never involved. ECHOING RIDGE chased early then faded along the rail on the turn. HOLBORN CIRCLE raced evenly through the turn then wore down in upper stretch. CAST NO SHADOW failed to respond. DEVIL'S PET unruly loading the gate would lose ground before tiring. MORNING GLOW broke well pressing inside of BOOTS then ceding and chasing that one through the turn, was worn out entering the lane.
