ELUSIVE VISION chased early pressing up three deep on the turn, dueled abreast down the lane edging up gamely. SIX MILLER'S saved ground, rallied to upper stretch, angled off the rail finishing well. JAY ARTHUR away alertly nursed a short lead to upper stretch, hooked inside ceded grudgingly late. SKY MISSION slow early came six wide upper stretch, gained late with even action. HIGHEST PLACE pursued the pace through the turn, came five wide upper stretch, weakened. HOMERSRUN hustled out pursued through the turn then wore down upper stretch. KARATE KING saved ground playing no factor. WORKING ON A DREAM was always outrun. GRAN TIRO labored throughout finishing wide. THE KAVORKA gave way on the turn.
