SHAMELESS RISK was patiently ridden to the quarter pole, launched rally coming five wide into the lane, raced outside of SAMURAI PRINCE from the eighth pole, drew even a sixteenth out, slowly edged away under aggressive handling. SAMURAI PRINCE settled early, rushed a four wide move at the quarter pole, led briefly inside the eighth pole, could not hold off SHAMELESS RISK nearing the wire, settled for second best in a hard effort. LATE NIGHT HOOKUP pressed for the early lead racing three wide, chased leaving the quarter pole, was outfinished by top pair besting rest in a good try. ALGEIBA rushed into the far turn, cleared and angled to the rail, headed in upper stretch, was all done at the sixteenth pole and gave way. WISH UPON THE MOON trailed to top of the stretch, showed belated action improving placing but failed to threaten. MASTER SPEAK broke alertly, vied briefly for the early lead, was in tight going into the far turn, lost path causing the rider to check and lost position, swung wide under a drive top of the stretch but lacked needed surge. STARLITS MISSION showed good early speed, battled for the lead racing between foes, was in close quarters going into the far turn, dropped off at the quarter pole, no factor in the stretch. NICE GUY made a three wide run mid turn, loomed off the leader at the quarter pole, began to give way mid stretch, used up. A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT ON THE FAR TURN RESULTED IN NO CHANGE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH.
