MANGO MANDATE went evenly, rallied five wide to upper stretch, dueled up gamely abreast rival. TENVINCE broke sharply, pressed the pace on the turn, dueled through the lane, ceded grudgingly late. RIGHT ON off slowly was circled out to lane, finished well at mid track. RASCOE sluggish early passed tired ones late. FORTE E POTENTI sent hard pressed three deep through the turn then wore down in drive. FAPPIE'S BOOKMORE played no factor. WHY WHY WYNN hustled out, pressed between horses, dueled through the lane, weakened. MIKES MONSTER tracked evenly, faded late. CHIPNCHATTER had brief foot, retreated on the turn. CELTIC PROJECT took a bad step, was pulled up and vanned off.
