Footnotes

NOONTIME BADGE quickly showed in front, set all the pace traveling in the two path, widened from upper stretch when asked for more, won easily being ridden out. FORREST RUNAWAY hustled and angled over to the rail shortly after the start, chased the winner from the quarter pole, failed to threaten but held second place in a willing manner. NO BUT CLOSE settled in the second flight at mid track, roused coming three to four wide entering the stretch, mildly bid picking up the show position but failed to menace. NO NONSENSE was outrun to the quarter pole, hugged the rail throughout, showed some interest in the stretch improving position but never factored. NORTHERN P S hustled leaving the gate, stalked then chased the winner turning for home, had little left by upper stretch fading in the drive. UNCLE DEN lacked speed running at mid track, offered little. PRIDEOFTHEFOREST showed brief early foot, chased to the quarter pole running four to five wide, gave way entering the stretch.
