**Footnotes**

WISEMAN'S FERRY prompted to lead, measured on pace, put down extended for stretch, held off hard charging rival. THE JUDGE SEZ WHO taken back, relaxed early, fired into 2nd turn, bid boldly late abreast leader, ran out of ground. CAPTAIN SQUIRE broke alert, stalked 3 wide backside, loomed into lane, remained in striking distance to wire, lacked punch. CAPPUCHINO sent along inside, chased close up, extended last turn, weakened from 1/4 pole. CALKINS ROAD went evenly at mid pack, retreated second turn, proved no menace. PASS RUSH came away well, stalked the pace, weary into second turn, had little left. ROGER E slow early, outrun throughout, was never involved. RUNNIN ON BRAVE was decisively outrun. DERBY DRIVE dropped back, struggled.
