REPRESENTATIVE was put to the whip leaving the gate wanting the lead, set a pressured pace throughout, repulsed challengers in mid stretch to draw clear late, won under a stiff drive. UP TO MISCHIEF steadied slightly in the first turn avoiding spill, settled in mid pack, swung out six wide upper stretch, surged strongly just getting up for second place. PILLOW PAL stalked a contested pace, bid four wide drawing even at the quarter pole, vied to mid stretch, leveled off late and was out noddod losing second place in last jump. WESH'S TEXAS STAR checked spill in the first turn, raced four wide down the backside, mildly bid top of the lane, failed to sustain move and leveled off. ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR had a good trip stalking a contested pace, bid in tandem mid turn, vied at the quarter pole traveling between rivals, began to tire mid stretch, no late threat. COMEBACK PAPA lacked speed and angled to the rail shortly after the start, was briefly steadied going into the first turn, lagged far off the pace, failed to factor. PRIVATE BENJ showed good speed pressing the winner early, was in tight and checked and steadied entering the backside, moved off the rail and dueled with the winner to the half, gave way top of the stretch finishing spent. RUN FOR FAME clipped heels and fell going into the first turn. THE RIDER OF RUN FOR FAME CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF PRIVATE BENJ FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE FIRST TURN, THIS CLAIM WAS ALLOWED AND PRIVATE BENJ WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST, ALSO THE RIDER OF PRIVATE BENJ CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF REPRESENTATIVE FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE BACKSTRETCH, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED.
