**Footnotes**

TEMPESTUOUS ONE stalked close up through the backside, pressed up challenging SIR WILLIAM on the far turn, shook off rival to go clear in upper stretch drawing out near mid track. SIR WILLIAM sent clear set the pace on modest splits through the backside, engaged by TEMPESTUOUS ONE near the quarter pole would cede into upper stretch dropping to the rail holding up for place. SEE THE THUNDER slow early raced evenly into upper stretch, hard ridden in the two path gained a spot late. DATE A SAINT unhurried early gave a mild move on the far turn then leveled off in the three path down the stretch. BAD ECONOMY away slowly stayed back throughout. KATE'S BLUFF racing evenly off the pace flattened out after a half mile. DAY ROAD folded up early. LITTLE ELI raced evenly early then wilted after a half mile.
