MONUMENT VALLEY lost ground to 1/2, advanced last turn, collared foe, driving. SASSY APRIL away alertly, widened on moderate pace, hooked inside, ceded. HIGH PROMISE laid close up, tracked to 1/2, roused for bid, lacked surge. SING JUBILEE broke well, chased leader backside, weakened in drive. JOANIE'S JETT slow early, varied little to lane, went evenly in drive. CASH RED JESTER raced mid pack, wavered last turn, no rally. SLAMMEINTHEDUST slow early, always outrun. SYL D'OR dropped back, labored. BUBBLY BROOKE brief foot, gave way.
